TIPS FOR HELPING YOUR MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT BE SUCCESSFUL

- 1. Establish a MYSTUDENT account as soon as possible. Start at the school's website with the parent/student link. Monitor the account weekly and email the teacher with any questions you have. Your child will have an account as well.
- 2. Check that your child is completing his/her planner every day. Each week planners are checked AND graded for the preceding week. Students will receive full credit for the following: parent signature, due dates for assignments, a brief note about what was done in each class each day, and a homework plan for the current week. Ms. A. will teach them how to do the homework plan.
- 3. NEVER ASK "Do you have any homework?" ASK INSTEAD: "What does your planner show you are working on tonight?" Homework occurs nightly.
- 4. Encourage your child to show you the directions when you look over his/her work. Most assignments come with written directions and a rubric. We want the students to learn the habit of self-assessment.
- 5. Help your student maintain an organized book bag. <u>Never</u> throw away loose pages that are academic. Keep them in a file until the end of the year in case the student needs them.
- 6. <u>Stay informed</u>. Make sure the school has your updated contact information so you can receive all automated phone calls. Bookmark the school website; follow TEWMS on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram. Shadow your child on MyLearning (aka Canvas).
