Dear Parents/Guardians,

It is that time of the year where we start planning for the 8th grade end-of-year (EOY) activities. Please read this packet carefully as it contains important information for your student's last semester in middle school. We will also post information, updates, and reminders on our school's FB page, along with our school's website so please stay informed.

8th Grade EOY Activities Eligibility Criteria

TEWMS 8th grade students wanting to participate in our EOY activities are expected to display a high level of well-mannered behavior at all times. In order to participate, academic and behavioral expectations have been established.

Any student who incurs the following academic or behavioral infractions during the current school year will NOT be eligible to participate in the planned events:

- Students with more than two on-campus disciplinary referrals or more than two bus referrals for the school year.
- Students who receive a level two or level three disciplinary referral in the fourth quarter.
- Students failing more than one core subject course up to the first semester of the school year, in which the course has not been recovered by the week prior to the event.
- Students in danger of failing more than one core content subject for second semester of current year. A grade check will take place one week prior to the event and final determination will be made on the Monday before the event.

These expectations have been communicated since the beginning of this school year with all students thru their classes. Further, students and parents were also asked to sign and return a copy of the 2021-2022 EOY Activity Expectation form (that is attached to the front portion of their TEWMS Student Binder). If another copy is needed, please ask in the back office.

In addition:

- All library books and textbooks must be returned or paid in full.
- Outstanding cafeteria charges must be paid in full.
- Sports uniforms must be turned in.
- Musical equipment must be turned in.

8TH GRADE ACTIVITIES

8th Grade Field Trip– Gradventure 2022

Universal Studios on Friday, May 20th from 2:30 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Cost: \$145 Total – Payments must be done online. Full payment accepted at any time.

1st - **\$45** due by **January 12th** (*\$45 Bus Fee NON REFUNDABLE beginning 1/12/22*)

2nd - **\$50** due by **February 11th**

3rd - **\$50** due by **March 11th** (*\$90 Ticket fee NON REFUNDABLE beginning 3/22/22*)

No late payments for the field trip will be accepted after March 11th.

- Price includes: **\$45** Chartered Bus Fee/ **\$90** “Special Event” Ticket/ **\$10** Class T-Shirt
- The first \$45 is a commitment to attend. This \$45 is used to reserve the busses that are pre-ordered and reserved on January 12. This \$45 down payment is **NON-REFUNDABLE** as of 1/12/22. Should your child become ineligible prior to 1/12/22, you are eligible for a refund. Beginning 1/12/22, anyone becoming “ineligible or cancelling” will not receive a refund for this \$45 bus fee.
- “Special Event” Tickets will be purchased on 3/11/22. Students becoming “ineligible or cancelling” on or after 3/11/22 will not be refunded the ticket price of \$90. Should your child become ineligible prior to 3/11/22, the ticket price of \$90 can be refunded.
- Eligible refund requests must be requested in writing and submitted to the bookkeeper: Elena Palermo at mpalermo@pasco.k12.fl.us prior to the deadlines mentioned above.
- Students must have a field trip ticket for park entrance. Universal passes or tickets CANNOT be used for admission on this field trip as this is a “Special Event”.
- Students must ride to and from the field trip on the Charter bus – no exceptions.
- Students are required to wear their 8th grade class t-shirts and will not be permitted on the bus if they are not wearing it. They will get their t-shirt on the day of the event. Students must follow all TEWMS and Universal Studies dress code expectations that is attached with this packet.
- We do not predict there will be a need for any parent chaperones.
- Eligibility check for grades and discipline will be completed one week prior to event. Notification will be made to parent if student is not eligible to attend due to grades and/or discipline.
- **Students who have paid for the field trip and lose eligibility to attend due to academic, disciplinary, and/or personal issues, refunds will NOT be issued – except as outlined above.**

8th Grade Dance –

TEWMS Gymnasium on Saturday, May 14th in from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Cost: \$20 (Payment must be done online – Payment window opens 1/4/22)

- Students must abide by the dance dress code that is attached with this packet. Students arriving to the dance in inappropriate attire will not be admitted.
- Students are not permitted to arrive or leave in limousines.
- Eligibility check for grades and discipline will be completed one week prior to event. Notification will be made to parent if student is not eligible to attend due to grades and/or discipline.
- **Students who have paid for the dance and lose eligibility to attend due to academic, disciplinary, and/or personal issues, refunds will NOT be issued.**

8th Grade Yearbook Signing Party

TEWMS Cafeteria on Tuesday, May 24th during 6th period.

Cost: Free

- Students can bring pens, autograph books, or previously purchased yearbooks to event.

8th Grade Promotion Ceremony

Wesley Chapel Performing Arts Center

Wednesday, May 25th (During School Day - Times will be announced at a later date)

Cost: **Free**

- Students are encouraged to wear casual dress attire that follows the school's dress code.
- Students who are failing or are short in credits of more than semester of their core classes will not be allowed to participate in this event. An eligibility check and final decision will be made by Friday, May 20th.

8TH GRADE T-SHIRTS

- Students who have paid for the field trip will receive a class t-shirt on the day of the field trip. The cost of the shirt is included in the price of the field trip.
- Students NOT attending the field trip may purchase a t-shirt for \$10 (S-XL) or \$12 (2XL-3XL)
- T-Shirts must be purchased online by March 11th.
- Adult sizes only: small, medium, large, extra large, 2XL, 3XL

8TH GRADE DANCE DRESS CODE

The Eighth Grade Dance is a special event that we all look forward to each year. We have put together the following dress code guidelines so that you can prepare ahead of time while shopping for appropriate attire.

Students are able to wear:

- A dress or gown that is "suitable" by covering the chest, torso, and undergarments. It must also follow the district's guidelines of not being shorter than four inches above the knee, and must remain appropriate length during movement. Dresses must also have straps (either two straps over the shoulder or one strap secured around the neck).
- Dress pants that are secured at the waist
- Collared dress or polo style shirt
- A tie and/or jacket (optional).

Students will not be admitted into dance wearing cargo pants, denim, jeans, t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, canes, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products.

Only students meeting the dress requirements listed above will be admitted to the dance. If you have questions or concerns regarding attire, it is your responsibility to speak with an administrator. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before the evening of the dance. If you arrive at the dance dressed inappropriately, you will be asked to leave or change before being allowed into the dance. **A refund will not be granted.**
