

## TEWMS will use TWO grading categories in MyStudent.

**Summative (70%):**  
Standards Aligned/Core Learning

- Chapter Tests
- End of Unit Assessments
- Projects (no collaborative grades)

**Formative (30%):**  
Standards Aligned/Teacher Determined

- Comprehension Checks
- Classwork
- Quizzes/CFAs

## Standards Based Grading

All grades must be based on mastery of the standards graded.

- Grades will not be given for completion, participation, or behavior
- No extra credit
- Assignments labeled in MyStudent by name/date/category
- Grades are to be updated and/or synced from MyLearning to MyStudent weekly (1 grade minimum posted)
- Grades in each category should be similar in value and weight based on task type

## Opportunities for Mastery

- Students are evaluated based upon their progress towards proficiency in Learning Targets to earn a class grade of A, B, C, or D.
- Students have multiple opportunities throughout the semester to improve their proficiency levels and to demonstrate mastery.
- Due to the nature of this grading approach, students are expected to turn in all assignments on time and complete revisions based on feedback.
- Grades for mastery are determined by student proficiency within a standard.

## Make Up Work

Students may make up any and all assignments, tests or related work assigned on the day(s) of any excused or unexcused absence at full credit provided that the student makes arrangements with teachers within three (3) days of the student's return to school as specified in the Student Code of Conduct.

- The student is responsible for asking the teacher(s) for make up assignments, tests, and related work.
- Students will be given a minimum of two (2) days per day(s) or class of absence to make up all assignments, tests, and related work.
- Students may be given additional time as stipulated on their IEP, 504 Plan, or based on teacher discretion. Work due to be turned in on the day of an absence will be turned in upon return.
- Students who have been assigned out of school suspension (OSS) may make up all assignments, tests, and related work from their absence.

## TEWMS GRADING SCALE

90 - 100 = A

80 - 89 = B

70 - 79 = C

60 - 69 = D

0 - 59 = F\*

\*Teachers will issue 50 - 59% for students displaying attempts towards mastery.

Incomplete (I): Should be used for no plausible attempt.
